Retreat has traditionally been a two-day, one-night event at a campsite. Again, Rotarians and inspirational speakers are invited to speak to Interactors. The purpose of the event is to motivate Interactors to perform acts of service not only locally but also internationally (i.e. our District Service Project). Sophomores, juniors, and club officers are highly encouraged to attend. The retreat has about 120 people and costs about \$130 per person (subsidies may be provided by their local Rotary club). Food is provided (three meals) by the facility. Students must find their own means of transportation, which may or may not be provided by their local Rotary club. RSVP is required and money must be given prior to the event.
